Create **PLAN**

Create an ICS chart with people, equipment, collections, and assignments, including key details.



ACTIVATE

As simple as adding your event details and clicking to activate the plan.



Manage **EVENT**

Manage all planned resources and any additional resources that are on-scene.

Manage All Resources in the Event

PEOPLE

Beyond your pre-credentialed personnel, additional individuals such as mutual aid, volunteers, patients, and more can be quickly credentialed and accounted for to ensure complete visibility and accountability.

EQUIPMENT

Track the issuance and use of equipment, both non-consumables and consumables, during an incident, including equipment issued outside your organization.

COLLECTIONS

Create collections that include both people and equipment so they can move through the event as a single unit, with the flexibility to remove resources that were planned for the collection but are not present.

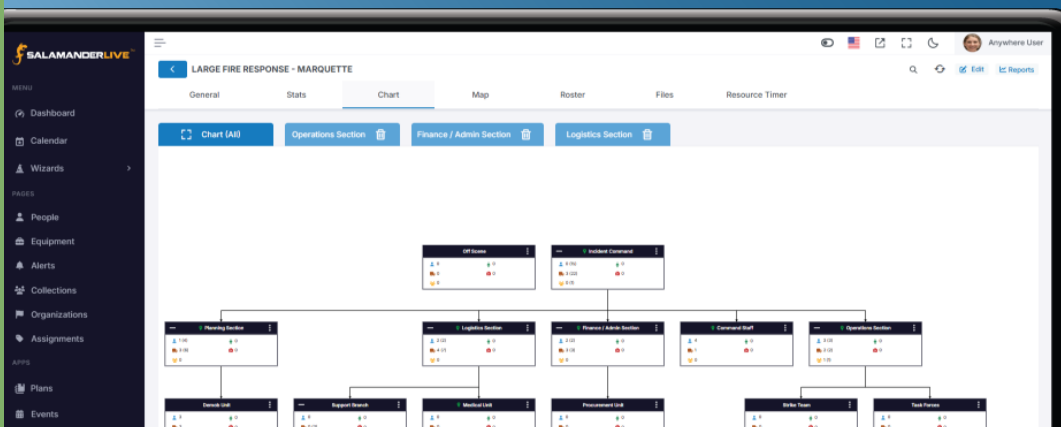

You Can Even Stage the Event Before it Happens!

Have Your ICS Chart Already Configured

Build your ICS chart hierarchy by loading each assignment with key information including resources.

Send Digital Credentials Before the Event

Send every planned personnel their QR code digitally before the event so they can be scanned and tracked when they arrive on-scene.

Communicate to Your Planned Roster

Email planned personnel the event-wide details plus the assignment information for their planned role, including the assignment location and any specific instructions.

See What Resources are Planned to be There

View all planned people, equipment, and collections within the roster. If additional personnel information is needed, easily view contact details, quickly access profile information, and send mass communications.
